(1933 - 2011)*



Sr. Margaret Lee, our beloved Principal in the 1970s, returned to God peacefully on 3 September 2011. Her funeral service was held on 6 September and a requiem mass was offered for the repose of her soul in the chapel of the Canossian Daughters of Charity, Servants of the Poor on 22 October.

Sr. Margaret was born in Hong Kong on 1 February 1933. On 14 August 1952, four years after her baptism, she joined the Canossians, making her first profession in Hong Kong in 1955 and her final profession in Rome in 1961.

Report on Mentorship Programme

A Mentorship Program was organized with the objective of fostering students of average standard to find their goals in life and strive for a better future. The pilot programme was launched in March 2011 and ended in mid-July 2011. In order to keep the programme manageable, 10 mentors were invited amongst previous committee members or friends of current committee members, and 10



mentees were selected from over 30 applicants based on comments from teachers. During the programme, each mentor was paired up with a mentee to interact regularly, to coach the mentee to become a better person.

On the whole, both mentors and mentees benefited from the programme. Mentees' ability to build up self-confidence and set clearer goals was generally enhanced. Such improvement can be reflected in their academic achievements in their latest report cards.

On the other hand, mentors appreciated the opportunity to learn about the concerns and culture of teenagers. They highly recommend that the activities be extended to a year round programme catering to larger audiences in future.
